

Absentee ballots available for December 13, 2016 Capital Project vote

Oppenheim-Ephratah and St. Johnsville residents who will be out of the area or otherwise unable to vote in the December 13, 2016 Oppenheim-Ephratah-St. Johnsville Central School District Capital Project referendum may request an absentee ballot.

All absentee ballots must be received by 5 p.m. on the day of the vote.

Polls for the December 13th Capital Project vote will be open from noon to 8 p.m. The referendum will have two polling sites. Voters from the previous Oppenheim-Ephratah School District will vote at the Elementary school at 6486 State Highway 29, and previous St. Johnsville School District residents will vote at the Jr/Sr High School Auditorium at 44 Center Street.

OESJ voter registration events planned

The Oppenheim-Ephratah-St. Johnsville Central School District has scheduled a voter registration for residents who are currently unregistered to vote but wish to participate in the December 13, 2016 Capital Project referendum.

Residents who are registered with the Fulton or Montgomery County Board of Elections do not need to attend these events as county registration already enables residents to vote in OESJ elections and budget votes.

Residents who choose not to be registered with the county Board of Elections can still register to vote in OESJ by filling out a personal registration form and bringing it, in person, to the OESJ District Clerk's office during normal school hours or to the upcoming registration event. County forms can be returned to the county Board of Elections through the mail.
