

Mrs. Gentile's Kindergarten School Supply List 2017/2018

Welcome to Kindergarten!!! This is a suggested list of supplies your child will need for the school year. I found most of these items at the Dollar Tree, Dollar General and Walmart.



Please supply a 6 qt. plastic container (I found this at Dollar Tree) with a change of clothing (socks, underpants, pants, shirt/hoodie) for lunchtime spills or other emergencies. In June I had several hats, mittens, black snow pants, hoodies, etc. go unclaimed. I strongly suggest putting your child's name inside ALL clothing and shoes. Since we do not have lockers or cubbies for the students, all shoes, boots, and outer clothing ends up in a pile on the floor. So many times I receive notes from parents looking for clothing items that are not in the classroom that may have been left in the bus, cafeteria, gym etc. without a name in them, they go to the lost and found and most of the time never get claimed.

I suggest a pair of sneakers to be kept at school for gym. We do not have gym on specific days of the week, so any day could be a gym day, and we do not have extra sneakers available. **No sneakers means No Gym.**

Our room **WILL** get very chilly in the winter, so I also suggest keeping a hoodie or sweater (please label it with your child's name) at school, and wear a long sleeve shirt or dress during the winter months. Believe me it gets very cool in our room, and I do not like to allow the kids to wear their winter coat during class.

In the winter, if the students go outside for recess, they are required to wear boots and snow pants, hats and gloves. These items may also be kept at school instead of transporting them back and forth to school each day. PLEASE put your child's name on the tag inside clothing.

Thanks to our Caring for Classrooms fund raiser and the generosity of many families from my class this past year I received enough money to supply pencils, erasers, color pencils, glue sticks and crayons. You may also supply these if you like, but not necessary. Those items will be community property for all to share.

We will have computers in our room this year and we will be using them everyday! But the school does NOT furnish headphones which the students MUST use so not to disrupt other students at work. The headphones will be kept in a bin that I supply for each student's supplies. I DO NOT recommend ear buds or the cheap earphones as the wires get tangled and snap very easily. Ear buds fall out of little ears, and get completely tangled. I found these earphones at Walmart starting at \$4.50 and up.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR Second Grade



Your child should bring the following items with them to school on the first day:

- ✍ **Book Bag:** Please make sure that your child's bag is big enough to carry a folder, winter clothes, lunch box, sneakers, etc. Label your child's bag with his/her name. ***Please do not send in book bags with wheels- they do not fit in the lockers**
- ✍ **1 RED, 1 BLUE, and 1 GREEN Two-Pocket Folder:** Please get a folder with the pockets on the bottom **NOT** on the sides.
- ✍ **Notebook:** 1 spiral bound one-subject notebooks (please label with name)
- ✍ **Headphones:** a set of simple headphones (no ear buds) to use for IReady. **If you had a pair in first grade no need to purchase another pair, the first grade teachers passed them on to 2nd grade.**
- ✍ **1 Composition Notebook:** These are the notebooks that are marbled, with a very hard cardboard cover. They do not have a spiral binding (please label with name).
- ✍ **At least 2 Black Expo marker:** (dry erase marker to be shared with class)
- ✍ **Pencil box** 1 pencil box that will fit in their desk (please label with name). Please make sure supplies can fit in the container.
- ✍ **Pencils:** 2 Dozen Yellow #2 Pencils (no mechanical or fancy) Ticonderoga or Dixon work the best in our sharpener. Pre-sharpened would be great! The students seem to go through these very fast. (will be shared with class)
- ✍ **Crayons:** Please only the 24 count crayons, at most.
- ✍ **Markers:** 1 pack -count of 8 (this is optional and will be shared with class)
- ✍ **Tissues:** One box of tissues to share with the class
- ✍ **Zip Lock Bags:** ~ Last name starts with A-G Quart size bags
~ Last name starts with H-Z Gallon size bags

Hello, third grader! To the right you will find a list of supplies that you should bring with you to 3rd grade in September. You can find many deals over the summer, so please come prepared in the fall.

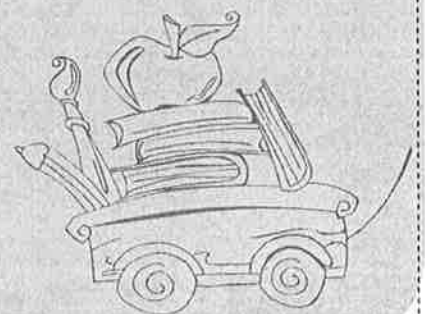

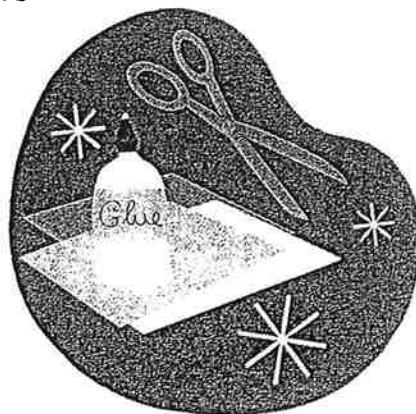

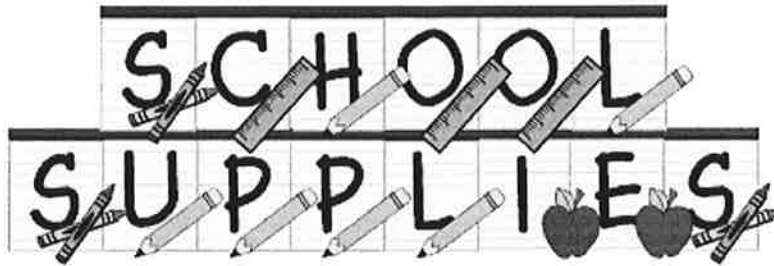
Supplies

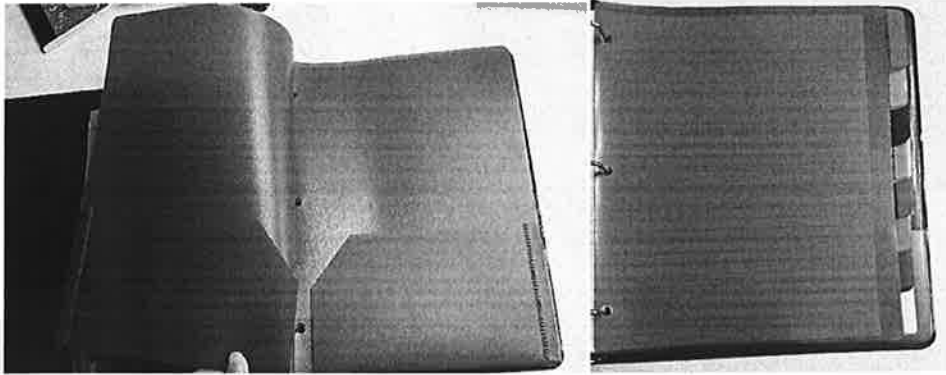
